SPECIAL CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEARS BABIES

Each year we visit the Bernice Samuel Hospital on Christmas Day and New Years Day and present the first baby born on both days with a special hamper.

On the top left is mom, Sindisewe that gave birth to a petit little girl on Christmas Day, and left below is mom Matibelo Moloi who gave birth to a strong baby boy on New Years morning.

Thanks to our community who continually donate baby clothing and goodies for these hampers!

We witnessed the Kingdom in action!

On 24 May Born to Care sent an outreach party to visit Touch Communities in Rustenburg –

Touch Communities started as Pregnancy Crisis Centre, called Neo Birth Rustenburg. And as a PCC, they realised that they needed to expand their vision within their Centre, if they truly wanted to bring transformation in their community. Through this expansion, their vision now includes caring for the orphaned and vulnerable children with no regard for culture or colour! (So called OVC) By adapting their centre and actively building into children's lives, they have remarkably transformed the community of Rustenburg, impacting 45 000 lives in the past 12 years!

This new strategy of theirs involves 80 caregivers who each take care of 20-30 children (OVC). These caregivers initially all receive basic counsellors training and continue with on-going training received on a weekly basis in all areas regarding children's needs. These caregivers then visit each child at least once a week in their homes, here she gathers a list of the children's needs. These lists are processed weekly at Touch Communities' office and through networks and partners they are able to meet these needs.

Statistics on every donation, service and training is kept, as they are presented in proposals for funding to donors who require this information.

They receive so much funding that all involved in Touch Communities receive market related salaries!

This is the KINGDOM!

We at Born to Care feel extremely challenged because we know that this is too, a concern on God's heart for the Greater Delmas area!

We feel very overwhelmed and can hear God instructing us to use what we have and start moving!

BORN TO CARE'S STATISTICS

Since opening in March 2008 we have done 162 Counsellings.

- 42 babies that would have otherwise been aborted were born. Out of these babies:
 - 2 were given up for adoption
 - 40 are being raised by their parent/s today
- 4 miscarriages
- 1 baby died at birth
- 5 women were not pregnant
