THE WAR AGAINST ILLEGAL ABORTION POSTERS

Born 2 Care declared war on Abortion and Penis enlargement posters littering our town 2 years ago. We joined forces with the town's intercessors to engage in this spiritual warfare and together met with Delmas' mayoress to voice our grievances regarding these illegal posters. The mayor, Cllr. Evah Makhabane, said that she arranges for a person to remove illegal posters in the main street occasionally. Despite this, the posters have spread across our entire town and have not only left our town looking a mess, but also proclaims lies and encourages that which we at Born 2 Care specifically are fighting in our community.

We have called on our Christian brothers and sisters in Delmas to join us in our fight by removing these posters and have as a result witnessed a vast improvement in our town. We also made an effort in February to print and legally put up posters around town stating the facts regarding abortions, explaining that it is NOT safe, without pain or after effects, to counteract the effect of the illegal posters.

But it remains an on-going war. We continue to encourage the community to remove a poster when they see one and to say a simple prayer while removing it that the people responsible will be saved and become part of God's Kingdom!

DELMAS DECLARES THAT LIFE IS PRECIOUS ON SANCTITY OF HUMAN LIFE DAY

Sanctity of Human Life Day is celebrated each year on the last Sunday in January worldwide. This year we got together and invited the greater Delmas community to

take a stand against abortion by sending balloons up into the air together, declaring that *life is precious!*

Over 500 balloons were released from the Delmas Golf Club at midday on 3 February and balloons were found as far as Middelburg.



BORN 2 CARE FOR THE COMMUNITY STATISTICS

We had seen a total of 193 clients as at the end of June, with 20 so far for 2013. Out of these 20, 5 parents chose to raise their babies, 1 gave her baby up for adoption, 1 client was not pregnant, 6 chose abortions, 4 are still undecided and 3 were social care clients.

DELMAS COMMUNITY BLESSES US WITH A BABY BATH FOR THE HOSPITAL

During January Born to Care for the Community received a bath stand which we were able to donate with 2 baths, 3 baby towels and some baby bath toiletries to our local hospital. All items were greatly needed.

CARE GIVERS' MEMORY BOX COURSE

With this knowledge they can help OVC kids receive emotional healing with the help of the Holy Spirit.



BORN 2 CARE'S VERY OWN LITTLE

Three years ago a client came to Born 2 Care for counselling whose mind was set on aborting her baby. She already had 2 little boys who were still in nappies and she simply could not afford to take care of another child. Our counsellor felt led through the Holy Spirit to ask this woman, "What if this baby is a little girl?" The woman left after the counselling very depressed and we never heard from her again. We had done what we could and left it to the Lord.

But our Father's will always prevails, as this client recently phoned us after seeing one of our pamphlets in the hospital and made an appointment to come and show us her PRINCESS! She greeted Heleen with tears in her eyes and said that she couldn't believe she almost never had Princess. She says her and her daughter are always together and she enjoys her so much! Princess is already 3 years old and radiates love and joy! It is clear this beautiful little girl receives tons of love!
